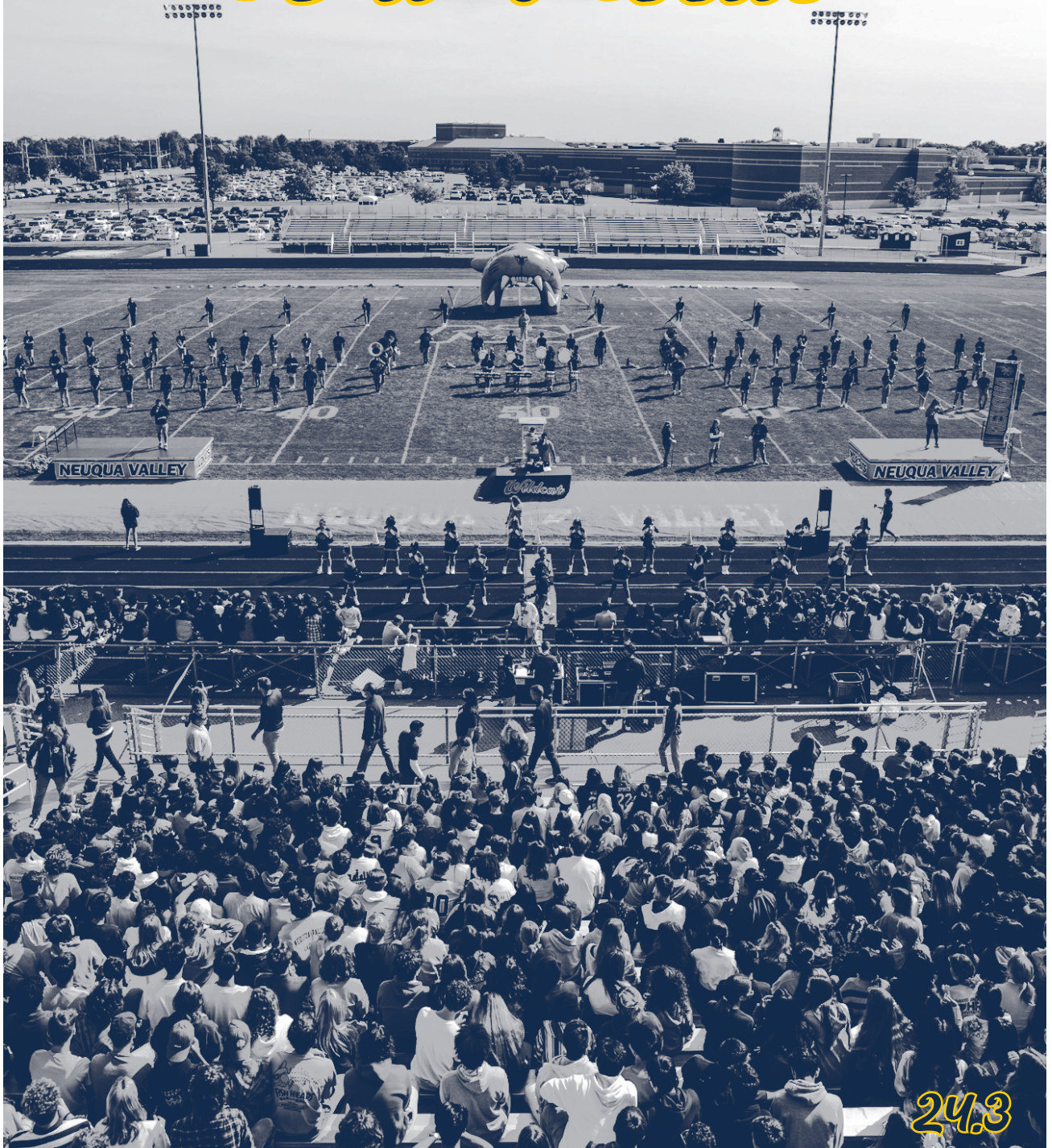


The Echo *Senior Issue*

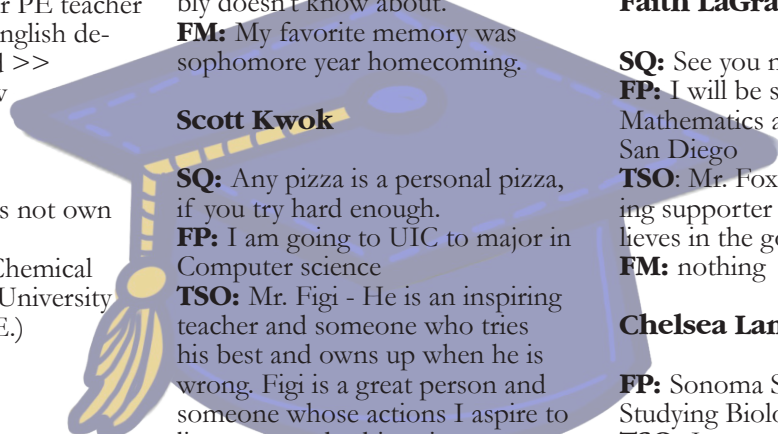

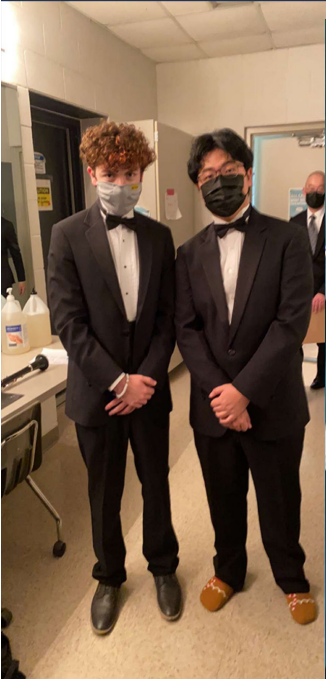
